JOSEPH: WEEK 1 | HOPE FOR DYSFUNCTIONAL FAMILIES

These are the generations of Jacob. Joseph, being seventeen years old, was pasturing the flock with his brothers. He was a boy with the sons of Bilhah and Zilpah, his father’s wives.
